



### Roxana Lead Service Line Replacement Information


The Village of Roxana is in the process of applying for a USDA loan. The reason for acquiring the loan is to meet the requirements set forth in the Lead Service Line Replacement and Notification Act (Public Act 102-0613).

- The Act requires the replacement of any lead lines in the water system and any water lines affected by lead.
   This requirement includes the Village of Roxana being responsible for replacing the water line into homes if that water line has been deemed affected by lead.
- 2. Roxana is committed to providing quality drinking water and has not found levels of lead during sampling that the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency considers a concern.
- 3. To continue Roxana's high water quality standards the Village is applying for a loan with the USDA that would assist the Village in paying for water main and service line replacement. This would include every residence having a new water meter outside and replacing the water line going into their residence.
- 4. You may have already received or will soon receive an access agreement and a waiver in the mail. Signing the access agreement will allow a contractor from the Village to install a new water line on your property and into your home if the Village continues with the replacement program. The waiver will provide you with the information necessary to make an informed decision and the ability to deny water service line replacement.

### Street Department Information

#### **Trash Collection Schedule:**

Trash collection days are **Tuesday and Thursday** for residents in most of the village. Residences and businesses located on Cemetery, Wasman, Wanda, Wagon Wheel, Hedge, Canal, Industrial, and Barton roads will have trash collected on Fridays. Visit our website for more information on our refuse ordinances, and which holidays may impact your refuse collection.

#### Leaf Vac Program Notice:

The Roxana Street Department operates a leaf collection program beginning **Oct. 1st and ending Dec.**31st (weather permitting). During these dates, if residents have any leaves they would like collected, please place them either near your normal trash collection area or in the grass between the sidewalk and the street in front of the residence. Please do not place the leaves in the gutters or streets as they can be washed away by rain and clog our stormwater system. Leaves are collected with heavy equipment and may not be collected if located too close to a building, vehicle, or another obstacle.

This collection is for <u>leaves only</u>. If your pile includes sticks, gumballs, grass clippings or any other yard waste, the leaves will not be collected as they can damage the machinery. Please place all other yard waste and grass clippings into biodegradable yard waste bags and place them in your normal trash collection area. Grass clippings and gumballs that are not bagged will not be collected.

#### Snow Removal:

Please try to remove vehicles from the roadways during a snow event when possible so that the street can be cleaned curb to curb. Failure to do so may result in your vehicle being buried during heavy snowfalls. It is suggested that residents wait until the streets have been fully cleared of snow before clearing their driveways. Failure to do so may result in the driveway approach being reburied.

#### Large Item/Bulk Pickup Notice:

The Village has recently placed a large 30-yard dumpster on the Street Department parking lot. The Village is requesting any <u>residents who are able</u>, to bring any large/bulk items they wish to dispose of and place them in this dumpster. The Village defines large/bulk items as: furniture, mattresses, fencing, or any other items that do not fit in a standard residential trash can. If a resident is able to relocate these items, please call the Street Department at 618-254-1951 and schedule a time to place the items in the dumpster. The Dumpster is accessible from 7AM to 3:30PM on business days. Yard waste and brush are not permitted to be placed in the dumpster.









### Back to School Traffic Safety Tips

Students are back to class for the 2023-2024 school year, which means we will see a lot more activity near schools and on the roads. The Roxana Police Department wants to remind motorists to be extra cautious in school zones, especially around pick up and drop off times. Here are some tips to help ensure safety in these areas and reduce traffic incidents.

- Slowdown in school zones.
- Obey all traffic signals and signs.
- Stay Alert! Avoid distractions behind the wheel.
- Watch for student drivers who may still be learning the rules of the road.
- Yield to school buses.
- Watch for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Be vigilant. If you see something, say something.



The Roxana Police Department evaluates evolving traffic needs around schools throughout the year. A Police Officer responds to areas where there are concerns of repeated violations and/or potential traffic hazards. We appreciate every effort to make Roxana a safe place to learn!

As we respond to criminal incidents, we may be able to use the information or footage gathered from the security cameras to assist in the apprehension and prosecution of the criminals involved. As a reward for partnering with the Police Department to help fight crime in our community, you will receive a \$100 gift card to a local Phillips 66 gas station.

### Burning Leaves / Campfires / Bonfire Permits

- The burning of leaves or any yard waste is prohibited by Village ordinance.
- The burning of felled tree wood for the purpose of a recreation 'campfire' is permitted by Village ordinance; provided that no garbage or any type of construction material is burned in such cases.
- Permits for recreational 'bonfires' shall be issued by the Fire Chief, at his discretion. These permits shall be applied for two weeks in advance of any event. Reasonable conditions shall be verified before any permits will be issued.

### Friendly Reminders



- On November 3, 2023 Daylight Savings Time ends and you should move your clock back one hour. The Roxana Fire Department would also like to remind you, this is a good time to change the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
- Building permits are required and should be obtained prior to remodeling or structure maintenance.
   There is no charge except for new residential/commercial construction.
- If you plan on leaving town, contact the Roxana Police Department for extra patrol of your residence. This is done as a public service free of charge.
- No dog or cat shall be permitted to run at large in the Village. Any dog or cat found in the Village without
  a current license tag or running at large shall be deemed a nuisance.
- Animal tags can be purchased for \$5.00 at the Roxana Village Clerk's Office.




### Community Yard Sale



Roxana Community School District is dedicated to partnering with the community agencies to meet the needs of our students and families. This is the second year for the SIHF mobile School Based Health Center and the second year for the Family Resource Center that is staffed by full time parent advocates.

For several years, Refuge has enjoyed an excellent collaborative relationship with Roxana CUSD—partnering to provide students with counseling services and district staff and personnel with training on implementing trauma-informed approaches to classroom interventions. The full-time partnership piloted between Roxana CUSD and Refuge during the 2021-2022 academic year has continued and grown. The intent of this partnership is to engage students and their caregivers in mental health services provided by qualified, licensed clinical staff. 
#### Family Resource Center-Parent Advocate, Bethany Martin and Ryan Peters

### Recent & Future Park Improvements

In 2023, the Park District added two new gazebos, one at each end of the park. They were funded by the Madison County Community Development PEP grant
